## **CURRICULUM VITAE**

Adalberto Biasiotti got his University degree in Electronics, in Rome Polytechnic, specializing in electroacoustics and radio links. His research thesis was centered around a new type of directional sound transducer, subsequently patented.

Main area of interest was telephone and radio communications. After three years and three patents, he moved to design department, in charge of technical and commercial activities for audio and video distribution and switching systems.

Acting as deputy director, in charge of export activities, he got responsibility from offer to commissioning of many "round the world" projects:

- audio and video centres of Hellenic Authority in Athens, Italian Radio and TV in Rome, Radio Telefis Eireann in Dublin, NOS in Hilversum, Argentina radio in Buenos Ayres for Rimet Cup, the PA and simultaneous translation systems for Somaliland, Nigerian and Sudanese Parliaments (This one in cooperation with Roumanian contractors).

The gradual growth of alarm systems in Italy attracted his attention and since 1975 he started marketing German made alarm and central station systems. All major banks and other administrations were supplied, at top security clearance. The Italian central station network, operated by Italian Police (about 100 installations with capacities ranging from 50 to 1000+), was installed under his supervision.

In 1981, to get a deeper knowledge of all security related fields, including physical security, he moved on, as marketing and strategic planning director for the Chubb group in Italy.

Since September 1983, he is a free lance consultant, setting up a security consultancy company, fully certified according to EN ISO 9001:2000 (see attached certificate); the company takes care also of setting up a Training Centre, with a full range of security related courses.

The range of consultancy activities encompasses:

- The assistance to Courts in topics related to security, as expert witness,
- The risk analysis on behalf of major insurance companies,
- The design of security installations and development of tender documents, even for very high risk applications
- The design of terrorism related mitigation measures (see certification)

Biasiotti is a fully credited journalist and technical editor of the leading Italian magazine on security "Antifurto" and banking technology "Bancamatica". He contributes regularly to many magazines and has written a number of books on alarm centralization, CCTV, safelocks and banking project and planning, as well as information system protection.

On behalf of UNESCO, a multilingual (English, French, Arabic, Macedonian, Roumanian) booklet on guards security training is currently available, as well as a three volumes security manual for museum directors (English and Arabic).

In 1983, he started lecturing, alternatively in English and French, at ICCROM, in Rome, going on for many years. In the mean time, as UNESCO expert on the security of cultural heritage, Biasiotti has carried out missions Mali (National museum), in Kuwait (reconstruction of the Kuwait National Museum destroyed during the Gulf war), the Museum of Arts in Durham, North Carolina, USA, Roman Forum, Pompeii and Herculaneum excavations, Santa Giulia museum in Brescia, Italy, Modern art Gallery in Gallarate, Italy, NMEC in Cairo and many more.

Since ten years, A. Biasiotti is security consultant to Pompeii Archaeological Superintendency.

He has lectured in many meetings, around the world; is visiting professor on cultural heritage security related topics at University of Belgrade, Serbia.

In the last two years more time has been devoted to set up a cultural heritage protection programme during emergencies. Theoretical and practical programmes and simulations have been carried out in Macedonia, Pompeii, Kumrovec (Croatia), Brescia, Amman (Jordan). A similar programme is now organized in Lombardy (Italy), especially for Libraries and archives.

He is member of many national and international security standard associations and committees.

He is member of the Italian Association of Security Professionals (AIPROS) and of the Board of Directors of Italian Master Locksmith Association (ERSI).

He is president of the Italian Certification body for glazed surfaces and metal profiles, as well as committee member of many ISO 9001, 9002 and product certification bodies.
